If disposing of as combustible garbage, throw them into designated garbage bags (translucent) before putting them out. • Absorb liquid such as cooking oil with paper or solidify them before throwing them out.
	Tie with string in a crisscross		<p>Sort by type and bundle up with string in a crisscross before putting them out.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You may leave advertisement inserts in the newspapers. • Paper packets with silver linings should be disposed of as combustible garbage. • Fold fabrics and bundle up with string in a crisscross before putting them out. • Dispose of badly soiled futon, items with holes in them, scrap fabrics and bath mats as combustible garbage. • Please dispose of futons and blankets as combustible or oversized garbage. • Old clothes and fabrics cannot be used as resources if wet. Please put them into plastic bags or put them out on another collection day if it rains.

Wrap them in paper, etc. before disposing. • Place batteries and lighters in a separate bag before disposing. Note: Use up the lighter fluid or empty the lighter out before disposing. (Refer to the inner page for how to empty a lighter.) Tape both terminals of the batteries to prevent conductivity before disposing. Bring-in Day

Bring in your garbage during the opening hours below after sorting it. (Private cars, no pickup boxes) Commercial vehicles are not allowed.

Weekday 8:30 a.m. to 12 p.m., 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. (Garbage will not be accepted on holidays carried over to Mondays.)

Weekend Every second Sunday of the month, 8:30 a.m. to 11.30 a.m. (Garbage will not be accepted on other Sundays, Saturdays, & holidays.)

Things to note when bringing in garbage

- Sort your garbage according to the categorizes before bringing it in.
- You do not have to use the designated garbage bags when bringing your garbage in.
- Cover your garbage with a sheet when bringing it in to prevent it from being scattered around.
- Avoid letting garbage liquids drip out of your garbage when bringing it in.
- A weight-based fee will be collected. Please bring loose change. (The fee will be collected based on the total weight in a day.)
- Cut branches, bamboo, etc. to within 50cm before bringing them in.
- Please bring in your garbage only during the specified time.
- Cooperate with staff during weighing.
- You may be required to present your drivers' license to ascertain the source of the garbage.
- Follow staff instructions and drive very slowly.
- A fee will be collected even if the number on the scale doesn't change.

How to dispose of air conditioners, televisions, refrigerators, freezers, washing machines, clothes dryers

How to dispose

Arrange for a home appliance store to collect it
Pay the store where you are buying a replacement the recycling fee and collection transportation fee for collecting the unwanted item.

When unable to arrange for collection
Arrange for an approved company to collect it
Check with the manufacturer of the item before buying a recycle voucher at the post office, then making arrangements with an approved collection and transportation company and paying them the transportation fee for collection.

Bringing in it personally
Check with the manufacturer before buying the recycling voucher at the post office. Bring the garbage to the designated collection facility. (Refer to the following list.)

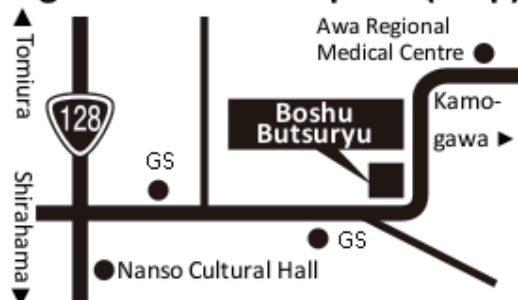

Dispose of lighters correctly!

■ Remove all the gas from your unwanted lighters before disposing!

[How to remove the gas]
Do this outdoors where ventilation is good and make sure that there are no flammables or fire around.



- Check your surrounding for fire.
- Press down on the lever. If it lights up, blow out the flame.
- Hold the lever down with a rubber band or strong sticky tape.
- If you hear a hissing sound, the gas is escaping. (If you can't hear it, push the flame adjustment lever all the way to the plus sign.)
- Leave the lighter as it is for half to 1 day in a ventilated place outdoor.
- Check your surrounding for flame. Continue if there are no such flames.

Small rechargeable batteries

Nickel-cadmium battery, nickel metal hydride battery, lithium ion battery



Remove small rechargeable batteries used in devices such as digital cameras, portable game consoles and electric-assisted bicycles. Check that there is a recycle mark on it, tape the terminals and bring it to a shop supporting recycling efforts.

PCs are recycled in accordance with the Law for Promotion of Effective Utilization of Resources

How to dispose

Call the manufacturer to make an appointment for collection.

- * Contact PC3R Promotion Association if the PC to be collected does not have a manufacturer (e.g. self-built PC, bankrupt manufacturer).

Devices with the PC recycle mark on them

* You will receive an "Eco Yu-Pack Label" from the manufacturer.

- For devices sold from October 2003 onward and have a recycle mark sticker, the recycling fee has already been paid for at the point of purchase. There is no need to pay another fee.

Devices without the PC recycle mark

* You will receive an "Eco Yu-Pack Label" from the manufacturer once you have transferred the recycling fee via the bank transfer form sent by the manufacturer.



- Wrap the PC up. Affix the manufacturer-issued "Eco Yu-Pack Label".

- Bring it to the post office directly or request for a home collection.

Also bring in all the accessories included when you purchased the device.



Peripheral devices such as printers and scanners are not accepted. Dispose of them as combustibles.

How to dispose of medical devices

- Unwanted packets and tubes from medical supplies should be disposed of as combustible garbage, not plastic.

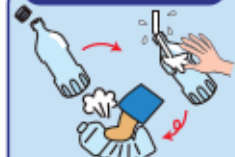
- Please contact the medical institution you frequent for the disposal of syringes, blood glucose monitoring equipment, etc.



Recyclables

Dispose of at collection stations (Household garbage)

PET bottles



Remove the cap, wash the inside, remove the label and lightly crush it.

Empty cans



Wash the inside and lightly crush the can.

Batteries



Place in a transparent or translucent bag and put it out on the day for incombustible garbage.

Old clothes and fabric



Stack and bundle up with string tied in a crisscross. Do not let it get dirty or wet. (Within 40cm in height.)

Magazines



Stack and bundle up with string tied in a crisscross (within 40cm in height)

Miscellaneous Paper

Put them out on the collection day for

Paper and fabrics

*If you are unsure of which category it belongs to, put it out as combustible garbage.



Bundle up with paper string before putting them out. * Do not mix with cardboard boxes

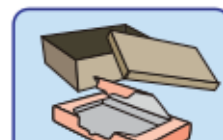


Consolidate in a paper bag. Tie with paper string before put it out when the bag is full.



If there is too little paper, sandwich them between the pages of a magazine before putting them out.

Please purchase the oversized garbage collection vouchers from stores carrying them. (576 yen tax included per piece) * If you will be present on the day of collection, you may purchase the collection voucher from the collector.

Affix the collection voucher on a prominent spot on the oversized garbage and put it out on the appointed date and location. * Please affix one voucher per item of garbage. Garbage without the voucher affixed on it will not be collected.

4

The collector will collect the garbage from each house. * Your garbage will not be collected if you have not made an appointment. Please remember to call to make an appointment.

Rules for putting out garbage



Put out your garbage on the day of collection before 8.30 a.m.

- Make sure that the contents do not spill out and it does not emit odors.
- combustible trash will only be collected if they are in association-designated collection bags.
- The garbage collection stations are used by everyone. Please abide by the rules so as not to cause trouble for everyone.
- Users are obliged to maintain the cleanliness of the garbage collection station and the area around it.
- Users should manage the recyclable resource crates at the garbage collection station so that they are not in a mess.
- If you are moving out, etc. and have a lot of garbage, please bring them to the clean center or call an association-approved company to collect them.
